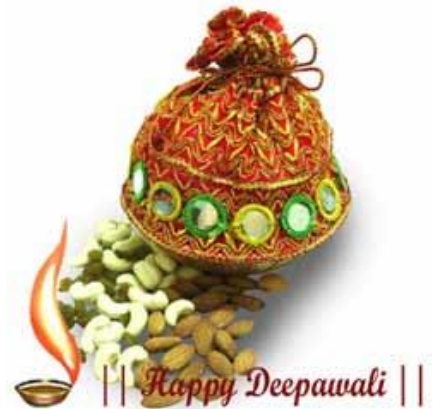

EDITORIAL

The previous quarter saw a flurry of activities at KLMA. Besides the routine courses, KLMA conducted the orientation courses for 20 deck cadets and 19 engine cadets. They



all attended a one week course covering various topics. All the cadets were briefed in SMS, ISPS, KYT, Risk assesment, Real danger sensing, among other work specific topics.

The deck cadets (in batches) were also familiarised with Bridge Equipment and mooring operations. Seen here are the cadets in the simulator room with Capt. N. Kasad. An open sea senario was simulated

and all the cadets were given a chance to practice their hand at steering the vessel.

This was the first “near seagoing” experience they had and all were thrilled after the exercise.



The cadets were also familiarised with valve hydraulics, level indicators and Gas meters.

They will now be assigned to various training ships for a period of four months and later distributed across the fleet.

First batch of trainees joining along with Instructors will be joining on the SUMR, HSKB, HSTB, HLLB and BRKB. Total 5 ships, with 8 instructors and 39 cadets in all.

The distribution on vessels is as follows:

Brooklyn Bridge- 5+ 5 and 2 Instructors, Houston Bridge- 5 + 5 and 2 Instructors, Helsinki Bridge- 5 + 5 and 2 Instructors, Honolulu Bridge- 5 deck and 1 Instructor, ,Summit River- 5 engine and 1 Instructor.

In September, KLSM and KLA were visited by Capt Iwamoto san and Capt. Hiroaki Kubo san from Mitsui OSK Lines. They had a very good look at the training institute and were very impressed with the facilities available for the training programs.

KLMA has applied for D.G. approval for specific courses. However due to an earlier ban on recognising new institutes, KLMA has not yet achieved this accreditation. The ban has been lifted but numerous clauses and riders have been attached to courses. However KLMA is hopeful that the Simulator based courses will be approved under the “Exceptions” clause in the near future.
